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1. INTRODUCING CAREERS NSW

The creation of Careers NSW is a recommendation from the NSW vocational education and training (VET) sector review led by David Gonski AC and Professor Peter Shergold AC, with the aim of providing career guidance to all NSW residents at any stage in their career.

An online pilot will begin through Service NSW later this year with a full rollout expected in mid-2022.

When fully operational, Careers NSW will provide a wrap-around service to:

- Provide tailored career guidance
- Identify educational pathways and qualifications that match individuals to the skills they need to enter or progress in their career
- Connect individuals with others currently in the industries they are looking to enter who can provide them with insight into the skills to succeed.

2. INTRODUCING THE SKILLS STUDENT SURVEY

The Skills Student Survey strategy was piloted in November 2020. Training Services NSW, in partnership with the Department’s Centre for Education Statistics and Evaluation (CESE), developed the survey strategy to better understand students’ goals and training experiences.

Following on from the pilot, the strategy will now be rolled out to all Smart and Skilled students by September 2021.

a. The strategy

Brief surveys are sent to students by SMS and email at four (4) key points throughout their training journey – enrolment, mid-point, completion/withdrawal and four (4) months after completion/withdrawal.

Each of these surveys has up to six (6) questions and takes under three (3) minutes to complete.

The survey questions focus around student satisfaction, what benefits students have received from training, whether students have accessed support services and whether the work that students secure after their training is related to their qualification.

All government-funded VET students of approved Smart and Skilled providers in NSW will be included in the surveys. Student contact details will be accessed through STS Online, as supplied at enrolment.

b. Purpose

The strategy will provide the Department with up-to-date, reliable data on students’ experiences and satisfaction with training across NSW. This data can inform market design, quality assurance, and Smart and Skilled provider performance assessment.

c. Data security

The surveys are administered using the online platform Qualtrics, with the data stored on secure servers located in NSW.

4. EXTENSION TO THE SKILLING FOR RECOVERY ENROLMENT PERIOD

At the Smart and Skilled Provider Webinar on Friday 3 September 2021, Minister Lee announced that the enrolment period under Skilling for Recovery has been extended from the current end date of 30 September 2021 to 31 December 2021.

The following dates now apply regarding enrolment of students and commencement and/or completion of training under Skilling for Recovery:

- **Full qualifications:**

Providers can enrol students up until **31 December 2021** and students may commence training up until **31 March 2022**.

- **Part qualifications:**

Providers can enrol students up until **31 December 2021** and training must be completed by **30 June 2022**.

- **For the Security Operations program (*Skilling for Recovery – Security Operations training to support the NSW hotel quarantine program and recovering industries*):**

Providers can enrol students up until **31 December 2021** and training must be completed by **31 March 2022**.

a. Training and assessment requirements under Skilling for Recovery and Smart and Skilled

Training and assessment under Skilling for Recovery and Smart and Skilled must comply with the following:

- **in Local Government Areas (LGAs) of concern**, all training is to be delivered online or deferred to comply with the Public Health Orders. Face to face delivery is not permitted. Apprentices or trainees can attend work subject to the Public Health Orders (e.g. if they are an authorised worker, they can leave the LGAs to attend work, subject to meeting the health requirements).
- **in Greater Sydney**, all training should be delivered online or deferred to minimise movement. Face to face delivery is possible but must strictly comply with any Public Health Order guidance.
- **in regional NSW**, all training should be delivered online or deferred to minimise movement. Face to face delivery is possible but must strictly comply with any Public Health Orders guidance.

b. Security Operations program

Providers approved to deliver the Certificate II in Security Operations (CPP20218) under Skilling for Recovery will have:

- enrolment/commencement dates on their current PASs extended until 31 December 2021; and
- end dates on these PASs extended from 31 December 2021 to 31 March 2022.

These adjustments will be made in the coming week.

c. Extensions to existing Skilling for Recovery part qualification PASs

Requests for extensions to the enrolment/commencement periods in existing PASs will be considered on a case by case basis.

Any extensions granted will be limited to a maximum of six weeks extension to the training commencement period. Requests for PAS extensions will only be considered where the following circumstances apply:

1. the PAS already has enrolments against it, but more time is needed to enrol students to fill vacant training places; or
2. the PAS has an identified cohort of students, but more time is needed to enrol these students.

Skilling for Recovery PASs without enrolments will be automatically withdrawn in the week starting 4 October 2021 unless a request under **point 2 above** has been submitted and is being considered.

Requests for an extension must be submitted to your Training Services NSW Regional Office **no later than 30 September 2021**.

Additionally, any requests for an extension must also include additional information depending on the mode of delivery, as outlined below.

i. Face to face training

For requests related to face to face training, the following information must be provided:

- rationale on how training and assessment will be conducted
- how training will comply with Public Health Orders
- that the training delivery site is in an area which allows for face to face training
- how the provider will maintain student attendance and engagement in training
- any further adjustments necessary for COVID-19 vulnerable cohorts.

ii. Online training

For requests related to online training, the following information must be provided:

- how the training and assessment will be conducted online
- SafeWork NSW approval for any SafeWork NSW connected real time delivery.

Please note:

Requests for extensions to PASs for Skill Up from Home will be considered in exceptional circumstances on a case by case basis. These requests must also meet the requirements detailed in **section 1.c above**.

Requests for extensions to PASs under the Security Operations program are not required, as these PASs will automatically be extended as per **section 1.b** of this update.

d. Construction induction training (White Card)

There should be no delivery of White Card training to school students during this current time. This includes face to face and SafeWork NSW approved connected real time delivery.

Requests to extend PASs for delivery of White Card training to this cohort will not be approved. Nor will any TNI applications.

Extensions to existing PASs for non-school student cohorts will only be considered for SafeWork NSW approved connected real time delivery and must include supporting evidence of employment outcomes post training delivery.

e. New TNI applications for Skilling for Recovery training

Providers can continue to submit TNI applications to their Training Services NSW Regional Office for Skilling for Recovery training, ensuring that these include information requirements as per **sections 1.c.i, 1.c.ii** and **1.d** of this update.

Please note:

For the time being, for Greater Sydney, TNI applications where training is wholly online will be given priority and, overall, priority will also be given to TNIs which include supporting evidence of a job outcome.
